If you've never quilted before, or are self taught, this is the place to start. Learn easy quilting techniques from the first cut to a finished quilt. You will learn basic techniques for rotary cutting, sewing straight, pressing, piecing, squaring, assembly, borders, layering, basic machine quilting, and binding. Class discussions will cover the selection, uses, and quality of quilting supplies including thread, fabric, and batting. Choose "Puss in the Corner" or "Children's Delight" pattern, from the book "Quilts from the Quilt maker's Gift". Plan one or two hours a few days before class to purchase basic machine quilting supplies on the class supply list and to choose the fabrics you'll want to use in your project.
